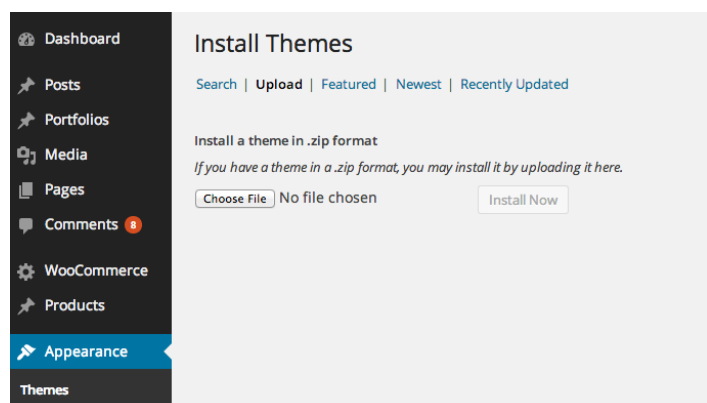

WPTF INSTALLATION

Once you purchase the item from Codecanyon you must activate the starting theme and the Hybrid Composer plugin.

Install theme via Wordpress Dashboard

1. Go to 'Appearance > Theme' section
2. Click 'Add New' and select the 'Upload' option
3. Upload the two folders of the Starting theme folder into /wp-content/themes/ or zip the folder wptf and upload it.
4. You're done



Install theme via FTP

1. Access to the file on your server using ftp editor program
2. Go to 'wp-content/themes' folder
3. Extract the zip file content folder there
4. Go to 'Wordpress Dashboard > Appearance > Theme' section to activate the theme
5. All Done :)

1. FRAMEWORK INSTALLATION

After the WPTF theme has been installed and activated, you will see a banner with a list of suggested and recommended plugins at the top of the WordPress dashboard, you must install Hybrid Composer plugin. The plugin is located inside the folder /wptf/inc/.
